- Answer NO if you 1) have never engaged in active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces, 2) are currently a ROTC student or a cadet or midshipman at a service academy, 3) are a National Guard or Reserve enlistee activated only for state or training purposes, or 4) were engaged in active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces but released under “dishonorable” conditions.
- Answer NO if you are currently serving in the U.S. Armed Forces and will continue to serve through June 30, 2010. (Please refer to question 1 above.)
