## MORE SCHOLARSHIPS!

The **Chabot-Las Positas College Chicano/Latino Education Association** is pleased to announce the availability of the 2010-11 college scholarship for entering, continuing and or transfer students. The Scholarship is funded through fundraising efforts of the Chicano/Latino Education Association (CLEA) and by supporting individuals dedicated to the educational achievement of Chabot and Las Positas College students.

### REQUIREMENTS:

1. Scholarships will be awarded to students based on goals, academic achievement, two completed essay questions, financial need and community involvement.
2. Applicants must be entering and or continuing students at Chabot College in Hayward, California or Las Positas College in Livermore, CA with a minimum of 6 semester units during Fall of 2009-2010.

### OR

Must be a student transferring to a four-year Institution in Fall 2010-2011.

3. A resident of Alameda and Contra Costa County

The CLEA Scholarship is effective Fall of 2010-11 academic year until Summer of 2011. In order to receive disbursement of the award CLEA officials will need to verify student's 2009-10 enrollment. Recipients of a previous CLEA scholarship are not eligible. The monies awarded will depend upon funds available during the application period. Past awards have ranged from \$200-\$1,000.00.

**Documentation**

1. Applicants must answer all of the questions herein this application with a letter of recommendation and a copy of transcripts no later than **April 9, 2010.**
2. The application must be thoroughly completed, typed and printed.
3. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
